SECTION 1 PART 80 – REGULATION OF FUELS AND FUEL ADDITIVES

New regulations for the National Renewable Fuels Standard Program for 2010 and beyond (RFS2) were signed into effect February 3, 2010. As part of this new rule, producers must register their facility with the EPA.

Incorporated within this condition is an engineering review, written report and verification that must be completed and submitted along with other registration requirements. The report and verification are based upon a site visit and review of relevant documents by an independent third party. The rule stipulates that the third party engineering review must also be conducted by a Licensed Professional Chemical Engineer. Furthermore, an independent engineering review will be required every three years after initial registration, or whenever the producer qualifies for a new fuel category or code.

Registration requirements must be submitted and accepted by July 1, 2010. Facilities must first establish an account with EPA's Moderated Transaction System at least 60 days prior to the compliance date.
