SEPTEMBER 14 MEETING – DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS

If you are traveling East on I-80, take exit 242 to your right. Turn right (south) at the exit ramp on First Ave. Within a mile, turn left on 2nd Street (also called Highway 6 or Coralville strip). After little over 1.5 mile, turn left on Burlington. After crossing railway lines, turn left on Madison. Take the very first turn on your left, go past Library, and take first turn to your left to enter the metered public parking lot. If this lot is full, come back to Madison, go straight and cross Burlington. At Prentiss, turn left and enter the parking lot 11 by taking the first turn to your left again. Feed the meters per instructions. Walk to your right, cross the Burlington Bridge, and turn left to Hydraulics Lab (see the map). Enter the building from North entrance and go to the classroom on the ground floor.

If you are traveling West on I-80, take exit 244 to your right. At the exit ramp, turn left (south) on Dubuque St. Go for about 2 miles and turn right on Iowa Ave. Next, turn left on Clinton and then right on Burlington. At the intersection with Madison, turn right and then take the very first turn on your left. Go past Library, and take first turn to your left to enter the metered public parking lot. If this lot is full, come back to Madison, go straight and cross Burlington. At Prentiss, turn left and enter the parking lot 11 by taking the first turn to your left again. Feed the meters per instructions. Walk to Burlington St, turn left, cross the Burlington Bridge, and turn left to Hydraulics Lab (see the map). Enter the building from North entrance and go to the classroom on the ground floor.

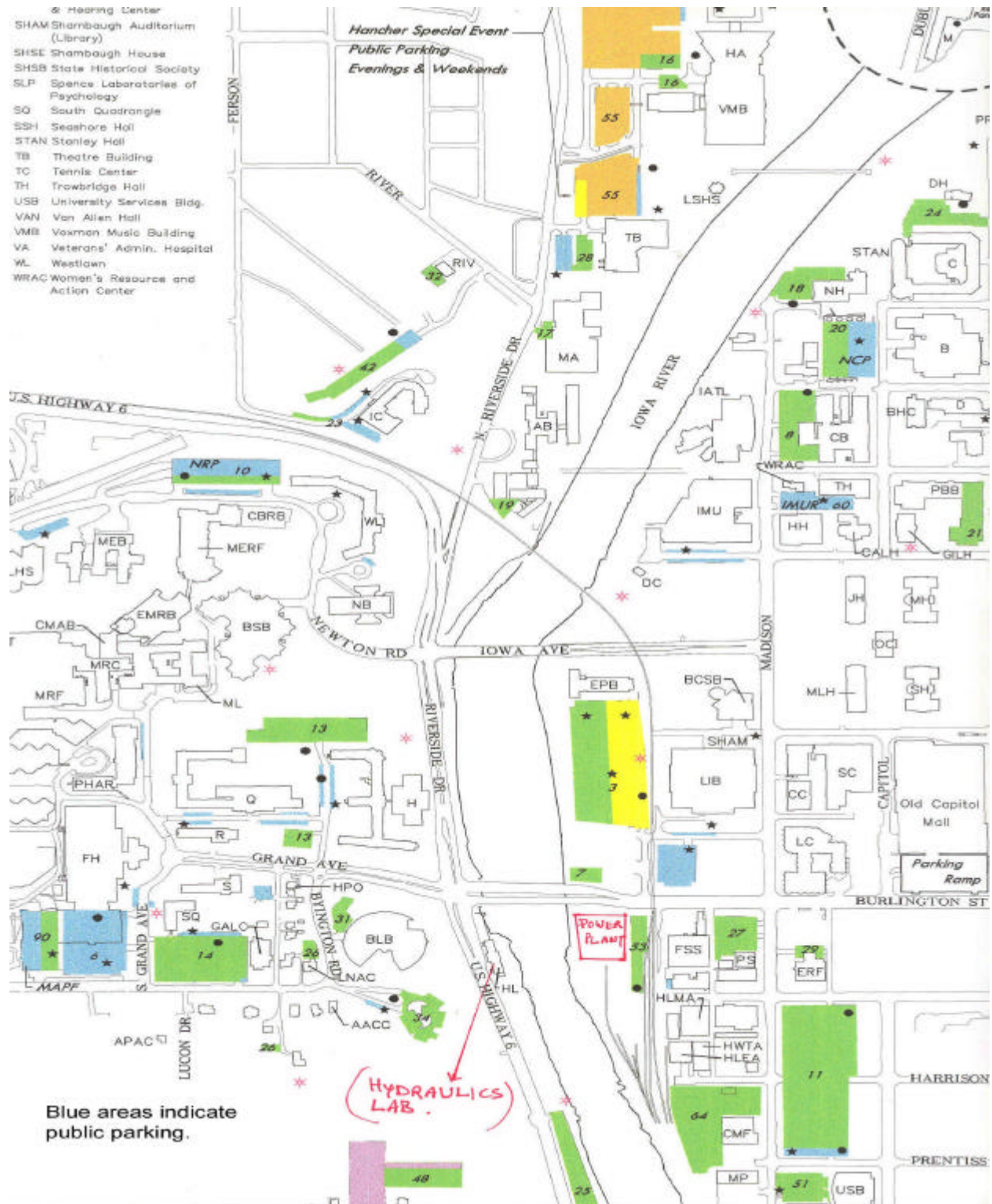
Q and A Form
