### **REGULATORY UPDATE**

Just a few highlights on regulatory changes from the last few months:

- Cathode ray tubes (CRT) used in computer monitors and other similar items have now been designated as universal waste instead of hazardous waste
- A new uniform waste manifest form (and rule) has been published. The new form must be used on all hazardous waste shipments after September 5, 2006.
- OSHA has issued new guidance on woodworking. This guidance can be found on the OSHA publications page.
- OSHA has issued a new guidance document on "Fire Service Features of Building and Fire Protection Systems." It is OSHA document 3256—07N 2006 and can be found on the OSHA publications page ([http://www.osha.gov/Publications/fire\\_features3256.pdf](http://www.osha.gov/Publications/fire_features3256.pdf)).

### **CHAPTER BY-LAWS UPDATE**
