### **SEPTEMBER'S MEETING**

Our first activity this fall is the Title V Application Refresher Workshop scheduled for September 16 at Amana Holiday Inn. From 1:00 until 5:00 DNR will be hosting an instructional workshop. Topics of discussion will cover changes to the application forms, emissions calculations, periodic monitoring, CAM plans and a summary of common application deficiencies. The compliance section will also review the semi-annual and annual Title V reporting forms and common errors found in the submittals. Question and answer sessions will be held during the presentations.

An evening presentation will follow the social hour and dinner. The evening presentation will feature a briefing on the PM 2.5 non-attainment designation for Muscatine and Scott Counties; a briefing on the status of the Boiler NESHAP and 112 (j) applicability; and a presentation of emissions data used in the development of National Association of Clean Air Agencies' Boiler NESHAP Model Rule.

In 2007 AWMA staffed a booth at this conference, held in Cedar Rapids, and took teacher requests for A&WMA's Environmental Education Resource Guides (EERG) for schools to use in their K-12 environmental science curriculum. Over \$2,000 was donated to schools through this

outreach event. This year, the conference is being held in Des Moines. The Iowa Chapter needs volunteers from the Des Moines area to staff a booth at the conference, which will be jointly sponsored by the Iowa DNR.

We are also looking for organizations to sponsor the purchase of these materials for 2008 by offering a pledge for one or more sets of EERGs. The cost per set is approximately \$60 with shipping and handling. A set of EERGs covers a three-year grade range on the topics of air quality and non-point source pollution prevention.
