## January Highlights

The January meeting was held in Little Amana. The topic was Title V compliance. Panel members were Doug Campbell (IDNR Title V), Bob Dougherty (Vermeer Manufacturing), Gary Douglas (John Deere), Don Mohning (Mid American Energy), and Christine Paulson (IDNR Compliance). The panel members gave their perspective of the process. Mr. Campbell summarized the Title V process from initial application submittal through the final permit. Mr. Mohning provided an industry perspective on complying with the periodic monitoring requirements. Mr. Vermeer talked about operating flexibility through developing a facility bubble permit. Mr. Douglas described some permit requirements, including stack testing and visible emissions. Ms. Paulson gave an overview of the annual and semi-annual reporting requirements. She also talked about some of the common violations.
