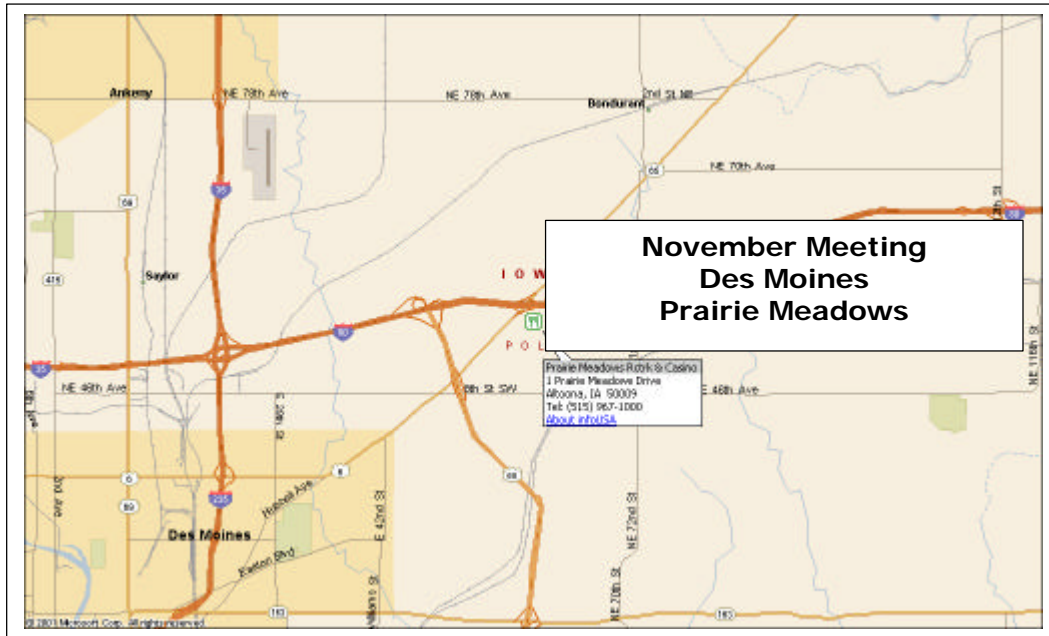
Membership Drive
